School Board Meeting Update

Regular School Board Meeting

Tuesday, August 22, 2023 @ 4:00 p.m.

C1.02 Proposed Hillsborough County Public Schools (HCPS) Uniform Testing Calendar for the 2023-2024 School Year

- Each school district must have a uniform testing calendar and publish it to the district website, and send it to the DOE, by October of each school year.
- Grades K-12 can't spend more than 5% of instructional seat time minutes on testing.

C1.03 Purchase of 7 Mindsets Online Portal License, Consulting, Coaching, and Customized District and Site-Based Professional Development from 7 Mindsets Academy, LLC

- Third year of implementing the 7 Mindsets curriculum. It is paid for from our mental health assistance allocation.
- The purchase agreement supports the state's plan to build resiliency in our students and includes support for over 50 elementary, middle and high schools.
- Aligned with Florida rule requiring instructional planning reporting section and resiliency education.

C2.02 Purchase of Digital Curriculum

- CTE department is requesting to purchase digital curriculum that will be used in various middle and high school CTE programs and career clusters, such as Agriculture Food and Natural Resources, Business Management and Administration, Health Science and Marketing Sales and Service.

C7.05 Increase in Expenditure for Invitation to Bid Regarding Diesel Fuel

- Supplement repairs to yellow fleet, active yellow buses and support vehicles. Red dye diesel is used in all yellow buses and some support vehicles.
- Due to inflation, the district has seen about 15 to 30 percent increases in fuel purchase prices; therefore, funds are needed to cover fuel costs

C7.14 Increase in Expenditures for HVAC Equipment, Installation, Service, & Related Products

- Approval of 8 million dollars is requested to repair and/or replace HVAC units or provide chillers. This does not include major/large construction. The district will have a vendor to repair or replace the units as needed.
- Currently 7 sites in need of major repair or replacement. Planning to replace chillers. Each cost about \$100,000 to \$300,000.
- If the A/C is out, there is a 24-hour turnaround time to assess the problem.
- The sales tax referendum has helped immensely.

C10.01 SirsiDynix Symphony Integrated Library System Software (Information Technology)

- Purchase license for the software that manages lending out books and tracking materials and catalogs.

A01 Adoption of Proclamation National Hispanic Heritage Month, September 15, 2023, through October 15, 2023 (Student, Family, and Community Engagement)

- Second annual Hispanic Heritage celebration will be held in District 1 on 10/12/23 from 6:00pm to 7:30pm. This will be held at Leto.
- More than 80,000 students in HCPS that identify as Hispanic.

A02 Adoption of Proclamation - Start with Hello Call to Action Week, 9/18/23-9/22/23 (Student Support and Federal Programs)

- Raises awareness about social isolation.
- Teaches students how to create an inclusive school culture.

A03 Adoption of Proclamation - National Suicide Prevention Awareness Month, September 2023

- Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death of 10-14-year-olds and third leading cause for people 15-24 years old.
- Positive mental health is essential for a child's healthy development.

A04 Recognition of Staff and Community Efforts Through Hurricane Idalia (Chief of Staff)

- Acknowledged and thanked staff who assisted during Hurricane Idalia.
- Schools were used as shelters.
- Staff helped with food and cleaning.

Superintendent Comments:

- Working with CTA for makeup of time missed during hurricane. One early release day will turn into a full day. Will know more at the end of August.
- All of our high schools in Hillsborough County made the U.S. News Best High Schools list, except for Sumner due to not having a 4-year cohort. Plant, Newsome, Steinbrenner, Robinson, and Sickles were named Top 100 in Florida.
- On 8/31 there was a Cybersecurity incident. Investigation is ongoing to see what data was impacted. Updates will be sent as information is uncovered.

5.01 Graduation Dates for the 2023-2024 School Year (Chief of Schools)

- The graduation schedule is available on the school district website.
- Graduations will begin on 5/21/24 and will be at the Fairgrounds.

7.05 Approve Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for the Curb Appeal Remodeling Project at Multiple Sites

- Discussed the installation of fencing, grass, window tint, landscaping, etc. to increase curb appeal at various schools in the county.

Hearing on Policies or Business:

01 Final Public Hearing on the Millage Rates and Budget for the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year

- Truth in Millage Law (TRIM) enacted in 1980. Under Section 200, Florida Statute requires the district to reveal the proposed millage rates and budget yearly.
- Required Local Effort - 3.1520
- Discretionary Millage - 0.7480
- Capital Outlay Millage - 1.5000

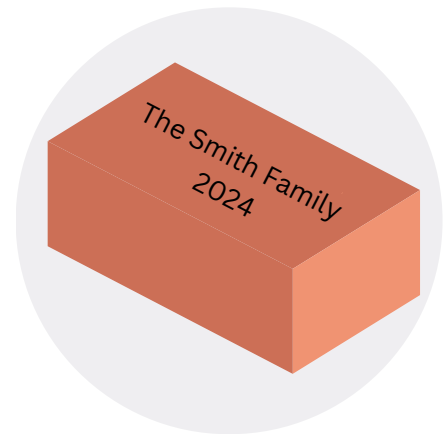

2023-24 SCHOOL YEAR



Students must be in uniform every day unless otherwise noted- no exceptions!

Martinez apparel maybe purchased through:

- Mascot Universe
- Land's End or any other store

Uniform Shirts:

- Colors: Solid black, gray, or teal
- Polo Style/Collared Shirt with Martinez logo or plain/solid polo.
- Students may wear any Martinez Middle School spirit shirt or College shirt on Fridays only.

Uniform Bottoms:

- Color: Solid Black or Solid Khaki
- Type: Shorts, long pants, long solid black leggings (not short style), skorts, capris, or solid black basketball shorts (no stripes and must be able to stay up without the drawstring)
- Length: All bottoms must be mid-thigh or longer.

ABSOLUTELY NOT ACCEPTABLE: Striped basketball shorts, jeggings, sweatpants, pajama bottoms, blue jeans, bottoms with rips and holes.

Outerwear:

- Students must wear their collared uniform shirts under their sweatshirts, hoodies, and or jackets.
- Must be a Martinez Middle School logo from the vendor or solid black, gray or white.
- Must not include large logos, designs, words or symbols.

Shoes & Accessories:

- Students must wear closed-toed shoes.
- Flip flops, slides, or sandals are not allowed.
- No hats, visors, beanie caps, or bandanas on campus.

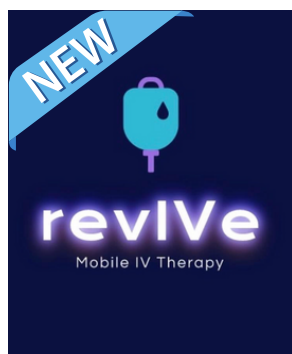
