Hello Mustang Families!

The first quarter of this school year is coming to a close, and we hope that your children are enjoying their experiences so far. Some of you took advantage of the opportunity to have a conference with your child's teachers during conference night. Our Hospitality Chairperson, Kristi Watts, provided a boxed dinner for the teachers to enjoy that night. This is a tradition we will continue throughout the school year, and we hope to be able to provide a variety of tasty options.

Although there continue to be restrictions with volunteering on campus, Our PTSA has been working hard with our membership drive and "Just One" fundraiser. We raised over \$23,000 during our donation drive! Thank you so much to everyone who contributed! As a result, the children earned all the schoolwide incentives that were offered, which includes a dress out day on October 8th. Please make sure your child adheres to school and county dress code guidelines when dressing out of uniform that day. 100% of these donations go to directly support our students and teachers. For example, this money has already begun supporting our teacher grant fund program bringing supplies directly into the classroom. We will also be funding devices for our students, which have been vital to learning during the pandemic and will continue to be a valuable tool in our children's education.

We also now have 526 PTSA members! Our goal is 1000 members for this year. Any student who joins the PTSA will get to take part in special rewards incentives throughout the year. Our first membership incentive is a dress out day on 10/22. Students will need to show their membership cards upon arrival to school to participate. Dues are only \$7 and help support a wide range of programs and events geared toward educating and building a sense of community. Volunteering is appreciated but not required. You can support our PTSA through your donations, membership, and/or time. You may join our PTSA through our website and make payments for the birthday marquee. We will also keep you updated through our Martinez PTSA Facebook page, flyers and emails.

Please also complete the PTA School of Excellence survey posted on our website and the PTSA Facebook page. We value everyone's input and want to provide an inclusive environment for our children, families, and staff. More information is included in this newsletter.

Martinez Middle School Uniform Policy

Shirts

- Type: Polo Style/Collared Shirt (May be purchased through Mascot Universe or any other store)
- Colors: Solid black, gray, or teal
- Students may wear Martinez Middle School spirit shirts or College Shirts on Fridays.

Pants

- Type: Shorts, long pants/bottoms, skirts, or skorts (May be purchased at any store)
- Colors: Khaki or black
- Length: All pants must be mid-thigh
- No jeans, leggings, jeggings, basketball shorts, or sweatpants.

Outerwear

• Students must wear their collared unform shirts under their sweatshirts, hoodies, and/or jackets.

Students have two uniform outerwear options:

• Option 1: Martinez Middle School embroidered hoodie, sweatshirt, or jacket purchased from the Martinez Middle School uniform vendor.

OR

• Option 2: Solid-colored (black, white, or gray) hoodie, sweatshirt, or jacket. Outwear cannot include large logos, designs, words, and/or symbols.

Shoes & Accessories

- Students must wear close-toed shoes. Flip flops, slides, or sandals are not allowed.
- No hats, visors, beanie caps, or bandanas on campus.
