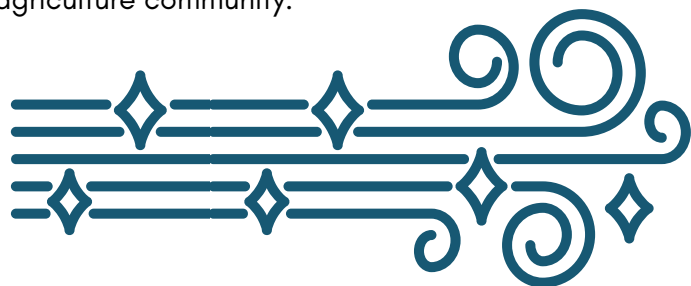


IN THE AGRICULTURAL LIMELIGHT
