*Effective for the 2019-2020 school year, uniform bottoms can be Tan or Black khaki pants, shorts, capris or skirts. <u>***ABSOLUTELY NO</u> <u>basketball shorts, NO yoga pants, NO leggings, NO jeggings, NO</u> <u>sweatpants, and NO workout tights!</u>

*Shoe requirements follow the Hillsborough County dress code which state "no tennis shoes with wheels or bedroom slippers".

*Students must wear their polo shirts Monday through Thursday, with the option on Friday, to wear a Martinez spirit shirt, a college t-shirt or their uniform polo.
